The Chief Inspectorate for English Instruction in Israel wants to visit your school as she disagrees to have 3 point classes in the school.

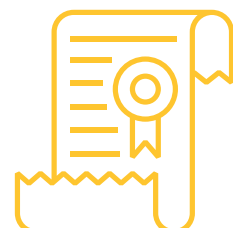

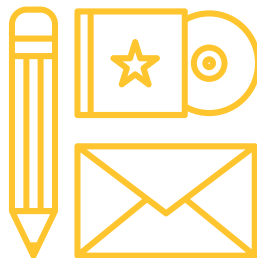
